Toddlers | December 8

OPENING

As kids arrive be sure they are engaged in an activity. For the next month, we will be talking all about Christmas and the season of Adventwaiting with anticipation for Jesus the Messiah.

NATIVITY SET

The nativity set will be out all month. As kids play with it, talk about each character and who they are and how they relate to the overall story.

STORYTIME and SNACK

Gather kids at the table to eat snacks. Watch The Angel Speaks to Mary and Joseph (Children's Bible Stories). Stop at "Pause for Storyteller" Ask questions like: What do we celebrate at Christmas? Who was born at Christmas? Jesus the Messiah. God sent Jesus as our Savior and the Savior for the whole world! Pray and thank God for sending Jesus and that we can celebrate that at Christmas time!

3-5s | December 8

OPENING OPTIONS (first 20 minutes)

- Coloring or Table Activities
- Christmas Tree Spiral Craft: Allow kids to color and add star and ornaments with string to the spiral Christmas tree. Read verse and talk about how this verse is from Isaiah in the Old Testament but it's talking about Jesus and how He will come.

BIBLE BOX

- About 20 minutes into the service, clean up and have kids select a carpet stump to sit on.
- Use the Bible Box story to tell the story with Bible Box props
- Worship- Joy to the World by Cedarmont Kids or worship in big room.
- Pray together and head into snack time.

SNACK

- Gather kids at tables to eat snack
- Snack: Talk about trust we trust mom and dad to keep us safe, feed us, remember to take us to school and church, etc. When is it easy to trust someone?
 When is it hard? Remind kids that we can trust Jesus no matter what!

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Bible Box | December 8

Hello! Thank you for coming to church today! I have a short video for you to watch before we open our Bible Box.

Watch- *The Angel Speaks to Mary and Joseph* (Childrens Bible Stories) Stop where it says "Pause for Storyteller"

Hi everyone, let's see what's in our Bible Box today! Hmm, here's our bible, a halo - that must be for an angel and some stickers. I will pass these out later, ok? You can trust me! Put stickers in front of you.

Trust means you do what you say you are going to do. I said I would give you a sticker later. You can trust me to do what I said I would do.

A long time ago God told his people that He was going to send them a Savior, His Son Jesus, who would change their hearts from mean to clean! But the people waited for such a long time that they did not think God would do what He promised. They stopped trusting God. *Make Sad Face*

Put halo on a student helper. After a long time, God sent an angel to tell Mary she was going to have a baby that was God's son, Jesus, the Savior. Mary did not know how God would make it happen but she trusted Him to do what He said He would do. *Everyone make Praying Hands*

Mary wasn't worried, she felt peaceful or calm, and she went to visit her cousin Elizabeth who was also having a special baby. They both knew God could be trusted! Wave Happy Hands

Pull out Advent Wreath. Advent means waiting for something good to happen. Each candle helps us remember God's promises. Today we celebrate the Candle of Peace – which means we can trust God to do what He promises! *Turn on candle*.

Were you worried I would forget to give you a sticker? Or were you feeling peaceful because you trust me? You can always trust God to do what He says He is going to do!

Prayer: Thank you, God, for sending Jesus so we could have clean hearts that love you!
