Our kids will be learning alongside the adults, and we encourage you to continue the conversation at home about what your family is learning together.

Today, each child is bringing home an offering can that they decorated themselves. Our main idea this week was: "**We are young, but God can use us.**" God uses every one of us to help grow His Kingdom, and we want our kids to know they are part of that, right now!

Over the next few weeks, encourage your child to fill their can, but not with your money. Help them think of ways they can earn money on their own, such as doing an extra chore or choosing to give up something they want to buy and putting that money in their can.

All of the money raised by our kids will go to a local organization that serves kids right here in Folsom called **Folsom's Hope**. We'll be talking more in the coming weeks about how Folsom's Hope helps care for kids in our community.
