During the months of **February and March**, our church will be focusing on What's Next for us as a church. As part of that focus, we'll be going through a series called **Not Without**. Our kids will be learning alongside the adults, and we encourage you to continue the conversation at home about what your family is learning together.

Today our focus was **Not Without Stewardship**. Building on the last two weeks, we talked today about the things that God has trusted us with (time, talents, money, relationships, His creation) and how we can be faithful with those things.

Over the last two weeks, kids brought home cans to begin filling on their own.

Please continue to encourage them to fill their cans! You can help them brainstorm ways to earn money independently, such as doing an extra chore or choosing to give up something they want to buy and putting that money into their can. ***If your child didn't make a can yet, they made one today. Cans will come back to church on March 15 so keep saving!***

All of the money raised by our kids will go to a local organization that serves kids right here in Folsom called **Folsom's Hope**. Over the next few weeks, we'll be learning more about how Folsom's Hope cares for children in our community.

NOT WITHOUT STEWARDSHIP

Read Matthew 25:14-30 as a family.
